

STEP 3: Learn about the Association for Women in Mathematics (AWM)



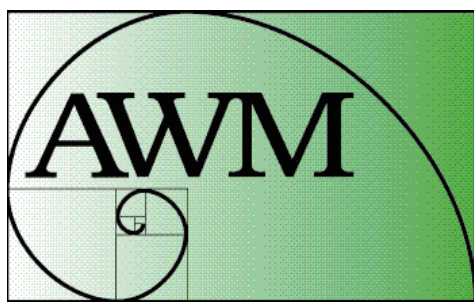

AWM's Logo

AWM has a logarithmic spiral on its logo. Spirals allow organisms to grow without changing their shape, just as AWM has grown while still keeping its essential character. AWM chose green and white for its colors because they were the same colors used for the 1972 Equal Rights Amendment (ERA).
