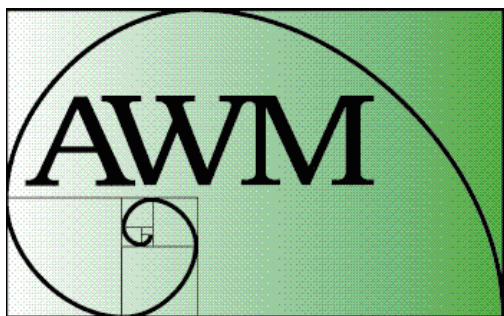


## STEP 3: Learn about the Association for Women in Mathematics (AWM)

### AWM's Logo

AWM has a logarithmic spiral on its logo. Spirals allow organisms to grow without changing their shape, just as AWM has grown throughout the years while still retaining its essential character. The green and white color scheme on today's badge is a nod to the color scheme of AWM, which in turn chose those colors because they were the colors used for the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) from 1972.
