

Activities are meant to be started with a good faith effort and ideally completed by the end of the listed day (or earlier, as they are already open!). However, there's some built-in flexibility: the final deadline is 10 a.m. on the next academic day. I strongly encourage you to work ahead and finish items when listed to stay on track. Every item on this PDF calendar is a "To do" or "Mark as done" item in ASULearn that must be "Done" at a passing level. This includes marking that you read postings, feedback and readings plus successfully completing interactive videos, quizzes, handwrites, re-engages, debriefs, and any other assigned activities. Strict 10 a.m. deadlines apply to handwrites and major assignments. Other items should be attempted on the day they are listed, but second-chance opportunities will remain open until 3/3 at 10 a.m. Some days are lighter than others and it will help you to progress on upcoming activities in advance. Note that the ASULearn Calendar may not show all required items.
