

# Media Conglomerates

- bias toward special interests, merge entertainment & news
- Thomas Edison–Motion Picture Patents Company in 1907–1908, which was a conglomerate of nine major film studios (commonly known as the Edison Trust)



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### *Motion Picture Production Code 1930–1968* Industry moral guidelines and censorship:

- pre-code films are surprisingly open in their treatment of sexuality, gender and gender roles
- moral importance of entertainment... effect on the lives of men and women is obvious
- Sex perversion or any inference to it is forbidden
- Miscegenation is forbidden
- Sex hygiene ... childbirth

#### N.Y. Allied President Declares He Was Not Invited to Classification Hearings

Buffalo—Declaring opposition to proposals to establish classification of motion pictures in New York State, Sidney J. Cohen, president of the Allied Theatres of New York State told THE FILM DALY yesterday that he had not been invited to any of the legislative committee hearings on the subject.

The hearings, under the auspices of the Legislative Joint Committee for Study and Dissemination of Offensive and Obscene Material, have been held in New York City and Buffalo, with additional meetings proposed for Rochester, Syracuse and Plattsburg.
