- men act and women appear




Gaze

- (heterosexual) male gaze is spectator and woman on screen (or parts of her body) is the object.
- Laura Mulvey (Visual Pleasure and Narrative Cinema, 1975)
- (heterosexual) female gaze?—man not reduced to object without agency



power structures in popular culture

 John Fiske—critiques power structures in representations of gender, race, and class that influence collective understandings of reality



gender: social construct

- society and culture create normative gender roles
- Erving Goffman (1976) Gender Display
- Doing Gender term coined by Candace West & Don Zimmerman (1987) in that seminal article



TV Tropes

- tropes—rhetorical devices, conventions that link storytelling stereotype, shortcut audience will recognize
- tvtropes.org established in 2004 by Fast Eddie
- In 2012 removed all rape tropes. Google threatened to block the site's ad revenue for explicit content. It was reinstated after complaints.
