- Nicholas Jackiw created *Sketchpad* as part of a visual geometry project headed by Eugene Klotz and Doris Schattschneider

Nicholas Jackiw: *They turned it into an illustration, whereas I wanted it to be a world.*

- Jean-Marie Laborde headed a team to develop *Cabri*

Colette Laborde: *The idea of movement in geometry is not new—the Greek geometers devised various instruments to describe mechanically defined curves...*

- Markus Hohenwarter developed GeoGebra

Markus Hohenwarter: *It's a good example of how the digital world can help us to spread ideas on a massive scale... it was basically a student project that... took off on its own by the power of the community. So that's really how I see GeoGebra.*
